Featured Event: This summer, the Carteret County Public Library is bringing education and fun together with a special children's event, *Whiskers, Words, and Wonders* which is a program designed to foster compassion for animals. These heartfelt letters will allow children to imagine the experiences of shelter pets and develop empathy for animals in need.

ADOPT-A-KENNEL UPDATE

Thank you for your support! All the dog kennels were adopted in 2024 and are now up for renewal. If you adopted a kennel last year, you will receive a letter from the shelter asking you to renew your dog kennel. If dog kennels are not renewed, then additional kennels will be available for adoption. In addition to dog kennels, you can now adopt a cat condo! Kennels/condos are \$525 for new adopters or \$500 for renewals. The form can be found on the website [Donate - CC Humane Society](https://www.cchshelter.com) under "Sponsor a Kennel or Condo." Money collected is used to help with food costs and care for the shelter animals.


